Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs have appropriate vaccinations and are free of communicable diseases and internal/external parasites.

ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE TRIAL SECRETARY'S OFFICE at 6PM April 29, 2026, after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled, or substituted. Make check payable to Medina Kennel Club. Canadian exhibitors must have fees payable in US Funds **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$35 to the amount of each returned check.

ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph or telephone entries cannot be accepted. **OVERNIGHT deliveries** requiring **NO** signature only. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

A RECORDING FEE OF **\$4.50** is to be collected on the first entry only for each dog, each day. An Event Service fee of **\$4.50** will be required for each regular class each dog is entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show Obedience Trial. These Fees are to be collected by the show giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competing by action of the Trial Committee.

NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE RETURNED if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the management.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. **PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT** carefully, the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

NO REFUND ON DUPLICATE ENTRIES. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRIES and a judging program will be made as soon as possible after entries close. Should such acknowledgment not be received within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary (tazrus23@hotmail.com or (440) 759.4794).

BITCHES WHO COME IN SEASON after the closing date may have their entry fees refunded less \$5.00 per entry upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial.

INJURED DOGS, which cannot compete due to an injury, may have their entry fees refunded less \$5.00 per entry upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be made to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial.

WHEN THE SAME DOG IS ENTERED in more than one class, only the highest score will be used for the top awards in Trial or top awards of a breed.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show giving club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED at the Trial or they become the property of the Medina Kennel Club, none will be mailed.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise ring. All handlers are asked to clean up after their own dog.

I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at this show, under the "AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines". I (we) agree that the club holding this show, obedience trial and/or agility trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. - (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
- The following categories or dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed.
