ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.) Dogs requiring registry in Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered and are subject to a separate registration fee of \$35.00 to the AKC.

TESTS, TITLES & TIMING

How Does a Fast CAT Work?

1. Fast CAT is a timed straight race of 100 yards.
2. Dogs run singularly.
3. The dog's time to complete the 100 yd dash is converted into mph
4. A handicap system is applied to a dog's MPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:
 - a) 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0
 - b) 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5
 - c) Below 12" = handicap is 2.0
5. Points = MPH multiplied by the dog's handicap
6. Fast CAT suffix titles are earned at designated milestones:
 - a) BCAT = 150 points
 - b) DCAT = 500 points
 - c) FCAT = 1,000 points
 - d) FCAT# = every additional 500 points
7. Timing Devices: The time to complete the 100-yard dash is recorded to the nearest 1/100th of a second (e.g. 9.11). The Club uses break---the---beam equipment to obtain the time but may use stopwatches. If stopwatches are used, there shall be two timers positioned at the finish line. An individual at the start line shall signal with an arm drop the moment the nose of the dog crosses the start line. The timers shall start their stopwatches at the bottom of the arm drop. The timers shall stop their watches when the nose of the dog crosses the finish line. The times from the two stopwatches shall be averaged to determine the recorded time.
8. Area of the course and field are fenced.

Please bring your own chairs, shade and water for your dogs. Porta John will be available. There will be no food or beverages available for purchase.

SCHEDULE: These are CONCURRENT tests. We will run in groups of 25.

Concurrent means you will run both of your runs in your group time slot.

TEST HOURS SAT-SUN

7:30 AM until completed

Workers dogs will run between 7:30 AM and 9:00 AM.

INSPECTION: Roll call starts 8:45 am on Sat/Sun. Arrive 15 to 20 minutes prior to your group start time. All dogs will be inspected for soundness and measured prior to running each event. All bitches will be checked for being in season prior to running each event. **All bitches will be checked by their handlers.**

DIRECTIONS & PARKING: Medina Kennel Club is located north of Chippewa Lake on Lake Road between Chippewa Road and Rte.162.

Coursing will be held in our fully-fenced, well maintained grass,13 acre back field. Parking will be determined based on softness of the back field. If wet, parking will be up at the training facility and you will have to walk to the back field.

RIBBONS & PRIZES

Qualifiers will receive a light blue flat ribbon for each successful pass of test.

MKC will offer a BCAT, DCAT and FCAT rosette for any dog finishing those titles.

RECOMMENDED THAT YOU LEAVE ONCE YOUR TWO RUNS ARE COMPLETE.

GENERAL RULES

1. All entries must be **one year of age** or older on the day of the test.
2. Each entry will be examined and may be measured with a wicket at inspection. Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit, or a female in season, shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees will be refunded. The decision of the field committee is final
3. Dogs may wear any type of collar except choker collars, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of catching on something during the run. Clubs may, at their option, require that tags hanging from the collar be taped up. Owners may have their dog wear a muzzle if they desire. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog with regard to the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog. Head halters, such as the Gentle Leader or Halti, may be used on the grounds but must not be worn while running the course. **NO FLEXI LEADS, PINCH/PRONG COLLARS OR ELECTRONIC COLLARS ARE ALLOWED on Medina Kennel Club Grounds.**
4. Continuous loop machines used. Lures consist of white plastic bags
5. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
6. There will be a \$15 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course progress (per AKC). The following actions may result in a fine and/or being excused from the event: exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct, foul language, not picking up after one's dog, or littering in any area of the event.
7. NO ONE is allowed on the field without the express permission of the Huntmaster, Field Chair or the appointed Field Committee.
8. There is NO SMOKING in the following areas: In and around the Paddock area, and around the Secretary's table, under canopies, and nowhere on the field itself. Please be respectful of others.
9. **There will be a \$20 charge for anyone not picking up after their dogs or themselves**
10. **There will be a \$10/5 minutes fee for not being able to catch your dog after 5 minutes on the field.**
