ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the FSS program, dogs with PAL numbers or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. (An event is defined by an event number.) Dogs requiring registry in Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered and are subject to a separate registration fee of \$35.00 to the AKC.

RUNNING THE COURSE

Each dog runs by itself and only one time in each testing event. They chase lures made of plastic bags that by string and pulleys follow a course in the field.

Any entered dog that is less than 12-inches tall at the withers or brachycephalic (i.e. “flat-faced”, such as a bulldog) will run a clearly marked 300-yard course, which must be completed in 90 seconds. Any entered dog that is more than 12-inches tall at the withers and not brachycephalic will run a clearly marked 600-yard course, which must be completed in 2 minutes. If there is a question as to which course a dog should run, the judge will decide. If your dog is 7-years of age or older, you may declare your dog a “veteran” prior to the start of its course and your dog will be allowed to run two-thirds of the normal distance. The Hunt Master is responsible for field safety and therefore is in complete charge of the dog and handler on the field. In service to this responsibility, the Hunt Master has the authority to stop the lure at any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve their dog. The handler should retrieve their dog promptly at the end of the course. Listen to the Hunt Master and follow their instructions promptly and swiftly.

The Coursing Ability Test (CAT) is a pass/fail test. In order to pass, the dog must chase the plastic lure and complete the course one time, by itself, with enthusiasm and without interruption, within the allotted amount of time. The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog’s performance. A dog that relieves itself on the course will fail the test.

Any decision made by the event’s officiating Judge regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the Judge to withhold a qualification for lack of merit. The Judge is responsible for ensuring compliance with the AKC Regulations on the field.

For the safety of the dog and as a courtesy to other exhibitors, your dog should have a reliable recall. Dogs that delay the event because they cannot be recalled may be refused entry at future events.

Area of the course is fenced.

All dogs run at owners’ sole risk. The hosting club and property owner, their agents, member, representatives, volunteers, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors and handler or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event

RUNNING ORDER WILL BE ANNOUNCED DAY OF THE TEST

TEST HOURS: 9:00 AM until completed.

ROLL CALL AND INSPECTION: Morning roll call and inspection starts at 8:30 am to 10:00 am on Sat/Sun. Afternoon roll call will be 30 minutes after the morning test has completed and will last until 12:00 pm. All dogs will be inspected for soundness and measured prior to running each event. All bitches will be checked for being in season prior to running each event. **All bitches will be checked by their handlers.** Roll Call and inspection will run continuously for the period of time listed. Bring your dog at any time during that period. Any dog that fails to present for inspection prior to the close of roll call and inspection will be marked absent. No refund will be given for an absent dog.

DIRECTIONS & PARKING: Medina Kennel Club is located north of Chippewa Lake on Lake Road between Chippewa Road and Rte. 162. Coursing will be held in our fully fenced, well maintained grass, 13 acre back field. Parking will be determined based on softness of the back field. If wet, parking will be up at the training facility and you will have to walk to the back field.

RIBBONS & PRIZES:

An orange ribbon will be awarded to each dog that receives a qualification towards a Coursing Ability Title.

Medina Kennel Club will offer a CA, CAA and CAX rosette for any dog finishing those titles.

GENERAL RULES

1. All entries must be **one year of age** or older on the day of the test.
2. Each entry will be examined and may be measured with a wicket at inspection. Inspection shall take place prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. In the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit, or a female in season, shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees will be refunded. The decision of the field committee is final
3. Dogs may wear any type of collar except choker collars, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of catching on something during the run. Clubs may, at their option, require that tags hanging from the collar be taped up. Owners may have their dog wear a muzzle if they desire. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog with regard to the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog. Head halters, such as the Gentle Leader or Halti, may be used on the grounds but must not be worn while running the course. **NO FLEXI LEADS, PINCH/PRONG COLLARS OR ELECTRONIC COLLARS ARE ALLOWED on Medina Kennel Club Grounds.**
4. Continuous loop machines used. Lures consist of white plastic bags
5. Medina Kennel Club reserves the right to alter the course due to field and or weather conditions on the day of the test.
6. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
7. There will be a \$15 fine assessed for any loose dog not taking part in the course progress (per AKC). The following actions may result in a fine and/or being excused from the event: exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct, foul language, not picking up after one's dog, or littering in any area of the event.
8. NO ONE is allowed on the field without the express permission of the Huntmaster, Field Chair or the appointed Field Committee.
9. There is NO SMOKING in the following areas: In and around the Paddock area, and around the Secretary's table, under canopies, and nowhere on the field itself. Please be respectful of others.
10. **There will be a \$20 charge for anyone not picking up after their dogs or themselves**
11. **There will be a \$10/5 minutes fee for not being able to catch your dog after 5 minutes on the field.**
12. At its discretion, Medina Kennel Club may break periodically during the day to accommodate Judges, workers and lunch.

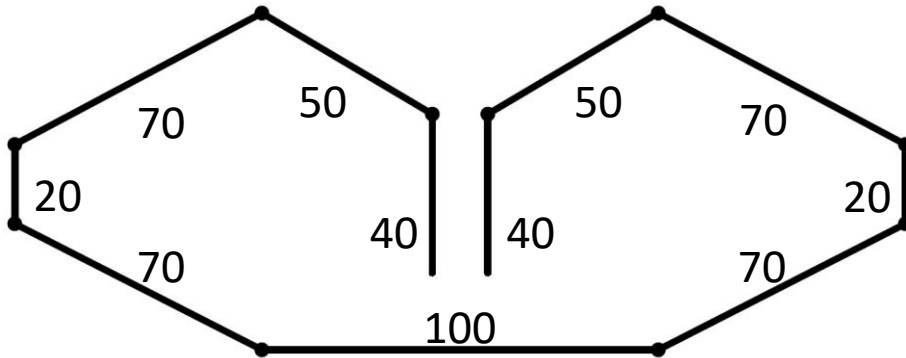

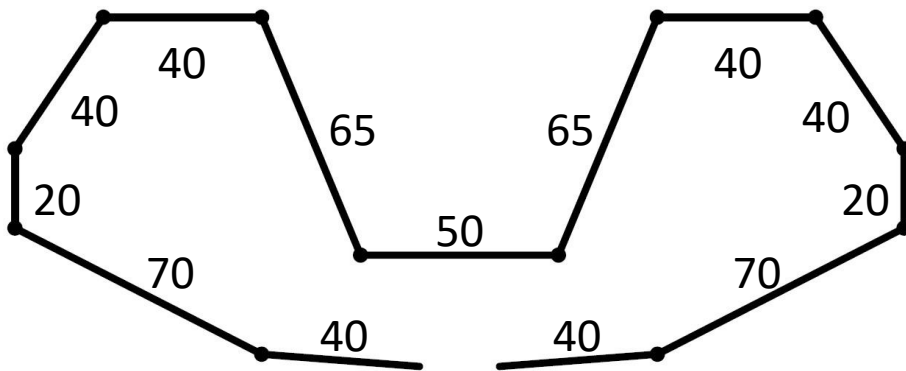
